The start of the Budget Construction (BC) cycle for FY23 is only a few weeks away. We wanted to share some important dates and information as we begin the process.

<u>Timing</u> – We plan to open BC on Monday, January 24, 2022. The completed submissions will be due back to Budget, Planning and Institutional Research by Friday, April 15, 2022.

<u>Positions</u> – Current employee data will be pulled from CORE as of mid-January. Similar to prior years, no vacancies will be loaded into BC. Once BC is open, users may add new positions/refills if needed.

**Permanent Budget Transfers** – The last day to transfer permanent funding for this fiscal year (FY22) is December 31, 2021. This allows the permanent funding in BC to remain static. One-time transfers may continue through the end of the fiscal year.

**<u>BC Data Load</u>** – The budget and actual data will be pulled from KFS as of December 31, 2021 (through fiscal period 06).

<u>BC Processors</u> – Within the next few days, each fiscal manager will receive a list of employees currently set up as BC processors. Please respond to that email with any changes.

<u>**Training**</u> – There will be a recorded training available on the Budget Construction webpage, similar to last year. Additionally, a virtual training will be available for users after BC opens. A separate communication will go out with more details. Users can also set up an appointment with their assigned budget analyst.
