RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Trustees approve the Spending Plan for Fiscal Year 2012 of \$817.2 million for the University of Connecticut Health Center. The spending plan was approved by the UCHC Board of Directors on June 13, 2011.

BACKGROUND:

The Fiscal Year 2012 Spending Plan includes \$817.2 million of revenue, including state funding of \$123.5 million (excluding fringe benefits), to cover \$817.2 million in expenses yielding a net gain of \$53,618.







University of Connecticut Health Center FY 2012 Budget Assumptions

Overall Budget Assumptions

- Increase in health insurance and retirement fringe benefits (6% health and 1% retirement)
- Increase in state appropriation
- Assumes no bargaining unit increases for unionized employees based on SEBAC agreement
- Includes salary increases that were provided in FY 2011 and fully recognized in FY2012
- Increase in salary expense due to furlough day savings in FY 2011 not continuing

Education, Research, & Institutional Support Assumptions

- Tuition and Fees for the School of Medicine (SOM) and School of Dental Medicine (SODM) assumes a 5% rate increase
- Grants and contracts revenues increase by 1.4%
- Full year of operating expenses related to the newly renovated 400 Farmington research building (increases to utilities, information technology, public safety, depreciation, repairs and maintenance)
- Increase in expenses related to the Connecticut Institute for Clinical and Translational Science (CICATS)
- Interns and Residents revenue increase of \$4.3m due to higher fees and expenses
- Increase in auxiliary revenue and other expenses related to increase in SOM & SODM contracts, higher capacity in Creative Child Care services and Paramedic cost recovery
- Repairs & maintenance increase due to ISS custodial services, clinical engineering and the DaVinci robot maintenance agreement

University of Connecticut Health Center FY 2012 Budget Assumptions - Clinical

Clinical - John Dempsey Hospital/Dental Clinics Assumptions

- Net Patient Revenue assumes a 5.3% increase, including the move of Dermatology to Hospital Provider Based Volume increase of 2% Inpatient Discharges, Outpatient Equivalents no increases
 Patient volume for Dental Clinics will increase mainly due to new GP3 Program concept
- Personal services and fringe benefits include Dermatology FTE's that are now charged to the Hospital
- Fringe Benefit Differential (per Approved Budget)
- Malpractice insurance based on historical payouts
- Medical/dental house staff expense reflects the expected wage increase (primarily Consortium)
- Assumes a reduction to outside agency due to budgeting at necessary staffing needs based on patient census
- Increase in Medical Supplies due to DaVinci instrumentation and estimated inflation increase
- Increase in other expenses related to nursing education and Magnet Status

Clinical - UConn Medical Group Assumptions

- Net Patient Revenue assumes a 4.4% increase (rate 2.2% and volume 2.9%) offset by the Dermatology move to Hospital Provider Based
- Malpractice insurance based on historical payouts
- Drugs decrease due to savings from 340B pricing
- Clinical faculty recruitment in Urology, Musculoskeletal, Dermatology and Cancer Center (primarily to refill vacant positions)






University of Connecticut Health Center Profit (Deficiency) By Fiscal Year




University of Connecticut Health Center State Appropriation w/o Fringe Benefits By Fiscal Year





John Dempsey Hospital/Dental Clinics Deficiency by Fiscal Year















UConn Medical Group Deficiency By Fiscal Year


