






#### University of Connecticut - Storrs & Regional Campuses Freshman Enrollment - Fall 1995-2014




## **University of Connecticut - Storrs Only Average Total SAT Scores - Fall 1997-2014**



#### **University of Connecticut - Storrs & Regional Campuses** Freshman In-State and Out-of-State Enrollment - Fall 1995-2014





### **University of Connecticut - Storrs & Regional Campuses** Freshman Minority Enrollment Trends for Entry Fall 1995-2014


