







University of Connecticut (Storrs & Regional Campuses) Freshman Enrollment - Fall 1995-2012

Comparison of Connecticut public high school Minority graduates to UConn Minority Freshman enrollment. Please note: in 2010, the CT Department of Education revised its methodology for reporting high school graduates and high school minority graduates from a graduate population census to a cohort graduation rate (ninth grade population earning a high school diploma within four years or less). The high school % minority before 2010 and beginning in 2010, therefore, are not directly comparable. Beginning Fall 2010 minority counts for UConn include the new federal category of two or more races.
